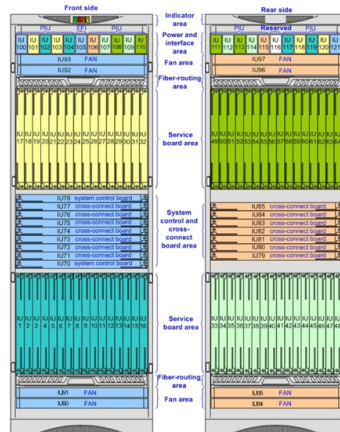

For ease of cable installation, the area of the cable divided by the area of the duct or conduit should be less than 53% per a single cable. Permissible area to be occupied for 2 cables is 31%, for 3 or more

Installation of Optical Fiber Cable by Blowing/Jetting

Cable blowing is the process of installation of optical fiber cable into a pre-installed duct. Compressed air is injected in the duct inlet after few hundred meters of cable is pushed into the duct.

Duct Installation of Fiber Optic Cable

All pulling equipment and hardware which will contact the cable during installation must maintain the cable's minimum bend radius. Such equipment includes sheaves, capstans, and bending shoes
