Height Above Ground: Cable trays should ideally be installed at least 2.3 meters from the ceiling or any other obstructions. UK electrical and fire safety standards do not prescribe a fixed minimum separation distance for roof-mounted life-safety cable trays. However, BS 7671, BS 8519, and BS 5839 collectively establish that life-safety circuits must be installed on dedicated containment and be either separated by. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material.
