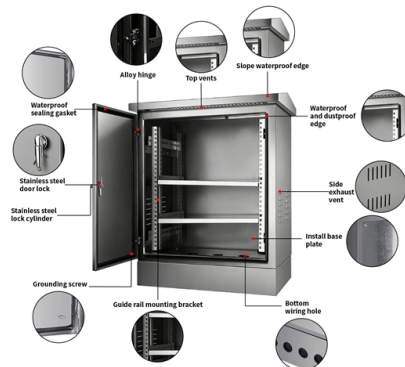


Electrical Information on the Secondary Distribution Box
