

From secondary distribution box to tertiary distribution box



Overview

Secondary packaging groups products together for handling and display – like shrink-wrapped multipacks or retail boxes. From the transformer's low-voltage side (0.4 kV), power is distributed to a main distribution panel (primary distribution box). 4 kV to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then the outgoing line is led to the distribution box (secondary distribution box) in each building, and finally the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet. From there, power is further distributed to the secondary distribution boxes located in each building, and then to tertiary distribution boxes in each unit, ultimately reaching individual households. Consumers generally don't see tertiary packaging, since it's often used just to add another layer of protection to the. A primary distribution box refers to the main distribution panel, usually located in the electrical distribution room.
