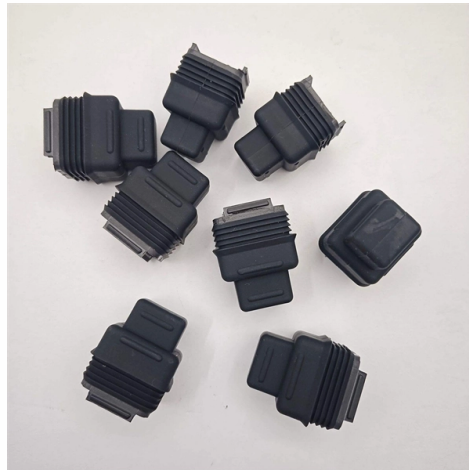


How long should network cables be left in the network cabinet



Overview

Generally speaking, Ethernet cables with RJ-45 modular plugs can have maximum length up to 100 meter before signals need regenerating via an Ethernet switch. I really like your approach: Terminating one end of the cable, leave the Cat5 box at your source port then routing/pulling the cable to its destination and then going back to the box and finding the length you need and then cutting and terminating it. Sounds much better than using a tape measure. An in wall network cabinet is a special type of enclosure that fits inside your wall.
