Single-mode fiber (SM) is designed to carry light signals in a single path, minimizing signal loss and allowing data to travel longer distances with higher bandwidth. With its small core size (typically 8 to 10 microns in diameter), SM fiber is ideal for applications in long-distance networks, such. Fiber optic joints or terminations are made two ways: 1) splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers or 2) connectors that mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear.
